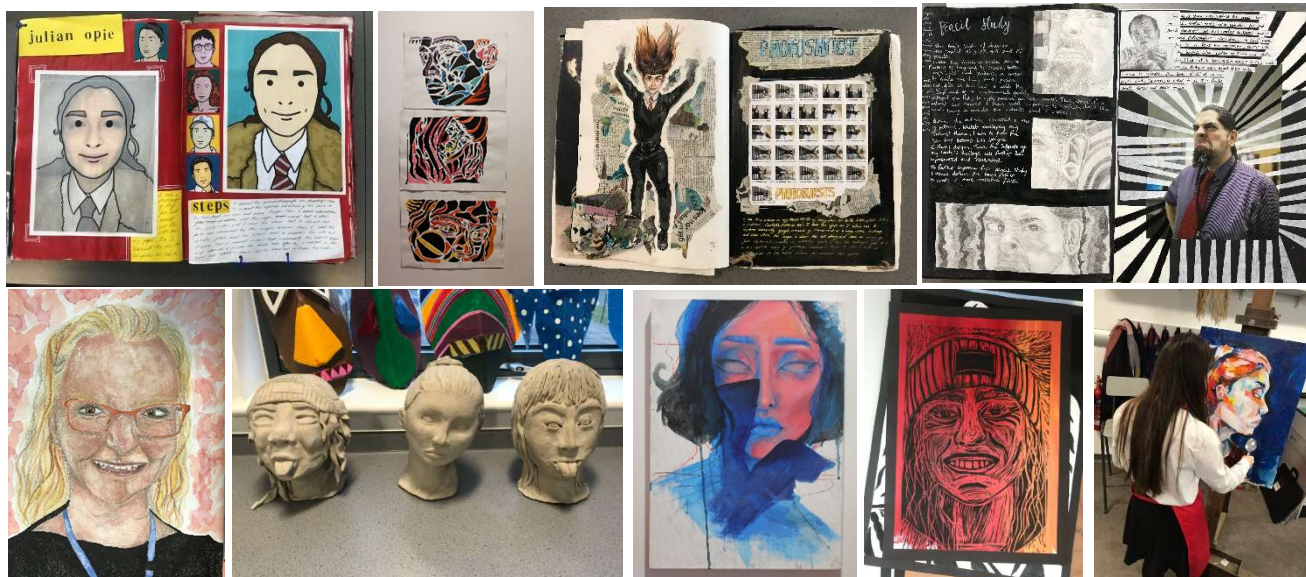


KS5: Art and Design

AS/A Level Art, Craft and Design

At Key Stage 5 level learners move on to study WJEC AS/A Level Art Craft and Design within the Art and Design department and/or WJEC AS/A level Art Textiles within the DT department. The Art, Craft and Design A Level is made up of three units; Unit 1 is completed in Year 12 and is a pure coursework unit, it accounts for 40% of the A Level Qualification. Unit 2 and Unit 3 are then completed in year 13. Unit 2 is again a pure coursework unit and accounts for 36% of the A level and Unit 3 is an externally set exam and accounts for the remaining 24% of the A Level. Whilst completing these units A Level Art learners work to further develop their intermediate and complex creative skills and they also utilise their literacy skills to produce sustained pieces of writing about influential artists and craftspeople. A Level learners are encouraged to independently develop and produce personal work that relates to current social and ecological issues.
